INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS GLOBALG.A.P.?

- GLOBALG.A.P. is a private sector body that sets voluntary standards for the certification and implementation of Good Agricultural Practice around the globe
- The GLOBALG.A.P. Standard is primarily designed to reassure consumers about how food is produced on the farm by minimising detrimental environmental impacts of farming operations, reducing the use of chemical inputs and ensuring a responsible approach to worker health and safety as well as animal welfare
- The GLOBALG.A.P. Standards are pre-farm gate or on-farm standards
- GLOBALG.A.P. is a business to business initiative
- GLOBALG.A.P. covers the certification of the whole agricultural production process of the product from before the plant is in the ground (origin and propagation material control points) or from the animal enters the production process to non-processed product (no processing, manufacturing or slaughtering is covered, except for the first level in Aquaculture)
